






Usefulness of Research in Professional Career




Relevance of Research in personal and social life




Difficulties In Research and anxiety


Comparison of Research Attitude & Its Dimension Between Male and Female

CONCLUSION

On the basis of result it can be concluded that:

- 1. Most of the Post Graduate students showed poor attitude towards research.
- 2. In General Aspect of Research and Research Process dimension of research attitude significant difference was witnessed. MCA students showed more favorable attitude towards research while MBA students showed poor attitude.
